Church Bus Rules

The Awana Club at Iglesia Bautista Northside provides transportation for any clubber living a reasonable distance from the church. While clubbers are riding the church bus, they are under the authority of the bus driver and/or chaperone on the bus. Any clubber who misbehaves on the bus will not be allowed to continue to ride the bus and therefore lose their riding privilege. In such cases it will be the parent or guardian's responsibility to provide transportation. REMEMBER, RIDING THE BUS IS A PRIVILEGE, NOT A RIGHT. GOOD BEHAVIOR IS THE ONLY WAY TO CONTINUE RIDING.

Instructions for Awana clubbers riding the church bus are as follows:

- 1. Respect the driver and or the chaperone by following instructions.*
- 2. Remain seated at all times and keep head and arms inside the bus.*
- 3. Passengers should keep their hands to their self.*
- 4. No pets or animals are allowed on the bus.*
- 5. Do not throw anything, at anytime, on or out of the bus.*
- 6. No eating, drinking, or chewing gum on the bus.*
- 7. Keep conversations quiet.*
- 8. No profanity, obscene language or inappropriate gestures are permitted on the bus.*
- 9. Clubbers must first present a permission slip/waiver, signed by the parent in order to be considered to ride the bus.*
- 10. Clubbers will be delivered to the address where they were picked up. No exceptions.*
- 11. Parents are responsible for notifying the driver if the clubber will be attending the club with ample time before the meeting.*

Our priority at Iglesia Bautista Northside is to provide a safe environment for all children that ride the bus. Failure to adhere to these rules can put everyone in danger. Please take time to review these rules as failure to comply will result in a loss of bus riding privileges for the clubber.
